An eventful life, begun in Bialystok, Poland in 1930, took Moshe with his parents to Israel in 1934. Following three wars, Hebrew University and work as announcer and news editor, he arrived in the US in 1968, to complete his PhD in Political Philosophy at Claremont, in California. Widely published on the interrelated topics of Middle East history, religion, politics and terrorism, he taught at Detroit universities, University of British Columbia and University of North Carolina, Wilmington between 1971 and 1994. An early proponent of the concept of "philosophical consultation", Moshe and his active, observant mind, will be remembered by all who met him.
