

Are you more or less religious than your parents?



The Transmission of Religion Across Generations project is researching how religion is (or is not) passed on from one generation to another in Canadian families.

We are looking to conduct interview with multi-generational families where everybody is religious, where only some people are, and where nobody is religious.

Families that participate in this research may enter their name in a draw to win a cash prize of \$500 (Canadian). The chances of winning are no less than 1 in 25.

To Participate:

At least one person from each of three generations must be willing to be interviewed (young adult, parent, grandparent);

All of you must be living in Canada or have lived in Canada most of the time that you were growing up;

The youngest must be at least 18 years old
