Volunteer Term:

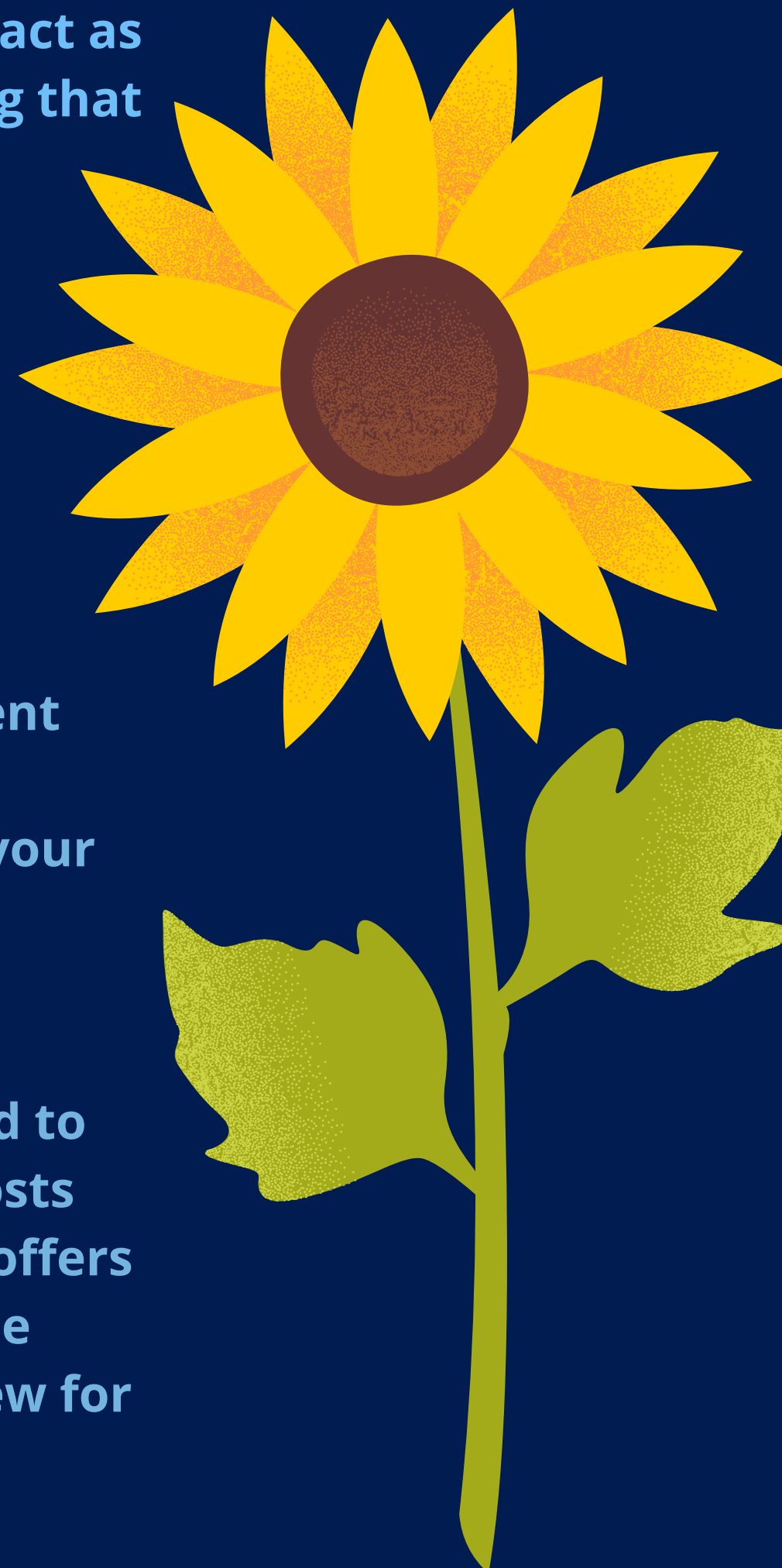
1 year, with a minimal time commitment.
